- A special freeway lane used only for carpools, buses, motorcycles, or decaled low-emission vehicles is known as a:
- Carpool/High Occupancy Vehicles (HOV) Lane.
- 2. If another driver does not dim his/her lights:
- Do not look directly into the oncoming headlights.
- · Look toward the right edge of your lane.
- Watch the oncoming vehicle out of the corner of your eye.
- 3. Using the _____ rule will help you maintain a safe distance between you and the vehicle ahead.
- 3 -second rule. When the vehicle ahead of you passes a certain point such as a sign, count "one-thousand-one, one-thousand two, one-thousand-three." If you get to the same spot before you finish counting, you are following too close.
- 4. Pedestrians and drivers must yield the right-of-way to:
- Law enforcement vehicles, fire engines and other emergency vehicles using sirens and/ or flashing lights.
- 5. Drivers must always yield the right-of-way to:
- Persons who are blind.
