If Applying for Regular Operator's License
(not Learner's Permit)

1. If you must drive in fog or smoke:

- Slow down, turn on your low beam headlights, and be ready for a fast stop.

2. At a four-way stop, if more than one vehicle reaches the intersection at the same time:

- The driver on the left should yield to the driver on the right.

3. If road or weather conditions are not good:

- Double your following distance.

4. Blind spots around a large truck are known as:

- "No Zones."

5. It is especially difficult to gauge the speed of a motorcycle because:

- They may appear to be much farther away than they really are.

6. A roundabout is an intersection where:

- Traffic travels around a central island in a counter-clockwise direction.

7. A yellow arrow means:

- The protected turning time is ending. Be prepared to obey the next light (red or green).

8. To avoid tailgating:

- Use the 2 -second rule. When the vehicle ahead of you passes a certain point such as a sign, count "one-thousand-one, one- thousand two." If you get to the same spot before you finish counting, you are following too close.

9. A teen driver with a Provisional Operator's Permit may not operate a motor vehicle between the hours of:

- 11 p.m. and 5 a.m.

10. U-turns are illegal:

- At or on a railroad crossing.
- On a divided highway by crossing a dividing section, curb, strip of land, or two sets of double yellow lines.
- Where you cannot see clearly 200 feet in each direction because of a curve, hill, rain, fog, or other reason.
- Where a "No U-Turn" sign is posted.
- When other vehicles may hit you.
- On a one-way street.
- In front of a fire station. Never use a fire station driveway to turn your vehicle around.

11. Center left turn lanes may not be used to:

- Drive more than 200 feet.
- Pass other vehicles.

12. Bicyclists have the same rights and responsibilities on the road as drivers of motor vehicles:

- TRUE.

13. When police, fire, or other emergency vehicles approach drivers should:

- Pull over to the closest edge of the roadway immediately and stop until the emergency vehicle has passed.

14. If you refuse to submit to a test for drugs or alcohol:

- Your driving privileges will be automatically suspended for one to four years.

15. The center lane of a three-lane or five-lane highway is used: only for turning left.

16. A red signal light means:

21. If there is a conflict between the signal light and the directions of a police officer:

- Obey the police officer - not the light.

22. A green arrow means:

- Go. You must proceed in the direction of the arrow after yielding to pedestrians, bicyclists, and vehicles close enough to be a hazard.

23. It is illegal to pass a vehicle stopped at a crosswalk because:

- A pedestrian you cannot see may be crossing the street.

24. When entering an interstate or freeway:

- Use the entrance ramp to signal and look for an opening in traffic, adjust your speed to match that of the traffic on the freeway.

25. When stopped for a school bus with its red lights flashing and its stop arm extended, you may not proceed until:

- The bus driver has turned off the flashing red lights and withdrawn the stop arm.

26. You can receive a ticket for driving too slowly.

27. If another driver does not dim his/her lights:

- Do not look directly into the oncoming headlights.
- Look toward the right edge of your lane.
- Watch the oncoming vehicle out of the corner of your eye.

32. If you need to stop after crossing railroad tracks:

- Wait until you can completely cross the tracks before proceeding. Make sure your vehicle clears the tracks before you stop.

33. Following a truck too closely is dangerous because:

- The trucker can't see you and, if he applies his brakes, you could crash into him.

34. The law that prevents anyone under the age of 21 from consuming alcohol is known as the:

- Zero Tolerance law.

35. When parking either uphill or downhill without a curb:

- Turn the wheels so the vehicle will roll away from the center of the road if the brakes fail.

36. If you come upon the victims of a vehicle crash:

- Do not move an injured person who cannot move or complains of pain in the back or neck. Do not attempt to remove the helmet of an injured motorcycle or bicycle rider.

37. If your vehicle starts to skid:

- Take your foot off the gas.
- Do not apply the brakes.
- Steer in the direction of the skid then steer in the direction you want the car to go.

38. Motorcyclists can stop much more quickly than a car so you should:

- Allow extra room between you and a motorcyclist ahead.

39. When parking downhill:

- Turn your front wheels into the curb or toward the side of the road.

42. When a pedestrian is crossing a public street or highway and the pedestrian is using a walker, a crutch, or an orthopedic cane or wheelchair:

- All vehicles must come to a complete stop.

43. Hawaii law requires that seat belts be worn by:

- The driver and front seat passengers.

44. Pedestrians and drivers must yield the right-of-way to:

- Law enforcement vehicles, fire engines and other emergency vehicles using sirens and/ or flashing lights.

45. When making a right turn:

- Begin and end the turn in the lane closest to the right curb.

46. You may pass, if it is safe to do so, when the roadway is marked with a:

- Broken yellow line.
