- 32. If you come upon the victims of a vehicle crash:
- Do not move an injured person who cannot move or complains of pain in the back or neck. Do not attempt to remove the helmet of an injured motorcycle or bicycle rider.
- 33. If your brakes get wet and start to pull to one side:
- Slow down and gently pump the brakes until they start to work correctly.
- 34. At a four-way stop, if more than one vehicle reaches the intersection at the same time:
- The driver on the left should yield to the driver on the right.
- 35. When stopped for a school bus with its red lights flashing and its stop arm extended, you may not proceed until:
 - The bus driver has turned off the flashing red lights and withdrawn the stop arm.
- 36. If you are driving slowly on a two-lane highway or road where passing is unsafe, and five or more vehicles are following you:
- Drive into the turnout areas or lanes to let the vehicles pass.
- 37. When entering an interstate or freeway:
- Use the acceleration lane to adjust your speed at or near the speed of traffic on the freeway so you can merge smoothly.
- 38. Louisiana law requires that seat belts be worn by:

- Give yourself plenty of time to move over to the exit lane and signal your intentions well in advance.
- 46. When a pedestrian is crossing a street or highway guided by a dog or carrying a white cane (or a white cane with a red tip):
- All vehicles must come to a complete stop.
- 47. If you refuse to submit to a test for drugs or alcohol:
 - Your driving privileges will be automatically suspended for 180 days.
- 48. A special freeway lane used only for carpools, buses, motorcycles, or decaled low-emission vehicles is known as a:
