If Applying for Regular Operator's License (not Learner's Permit)

- 1. A flashing Red signal light means:
- Stop. After stopping, you may proceed when it is safe. Observe the right-of-way rules.
- 2. Pedestrians and drivers must yield the right-of-way to:
- Law enforcement vehicles, fire engines and other emergency vehicles using sirens and/ or flashing lights.
- 3. Center left turn lanes may not be used to:
  - · Drive more than 200 feet.
- Pass other vehicles.
- 4. Hydroplaning occurs:
- When driving at higher speeds in heavy rain. Your tires can lose contact with the road and ride on top of the water like skis.
- 5. For the first six months, a driver with a probationary license:
- May not transport more than one passenger under the age of 20.
- 6. It is especially difficult to gauge the speed of a motorcycle because:
- They may appear to be much farther away than they really are.
- 7. When a school bus is flashing its yellow (amber) lights:
- It is about to stop; slow down and prepare to stop.
- 8. Parking is not allowed:
- Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant.
- 9. If you refuse to submit to a test for drugs or alcohol:
  - Your driving privileges will be automatically suspended for at least 90 days.

- 10. The "Not A Drop" law is the law that:
- Makes it illegal for anyone under the age of 21 to consume alcohol.
- 11. Under Minnesota law, seat belts are required for the:
- · Driver and all passengers.
- 12. Before changing lanes, signal, look in all your mirrors, and:
- · Check traffic behind and beside you.
- Glance over your left or right shoulder to make sure the lane you want is clear.
- Look for all vehicles, motorcyclists, and bicycle traffic in your blind spot.
- Be sure there is enough room for your vehicle in the next lane.
- 13. Under Minnesota law, a driver under the age of 21 can be convicted od DWI with:
- Any detectable amount of alcohol in the blood.
- 14. You can receive a ticket for driving so slowly that:
- · You impede or block the safe flow of traffic around you.
- 15. When exiting a freeway or interstate:
- Give yourself plenty of time to move over to the exit lane and signal your intentions well in advance.
- 16. If you come upon the victims of a vehicle crash:
- Do not move an injured person who cannot move or complains of pain in the back or neck. Do not attempt to remove the helmet of an injured motorcycle or bicycle rider.
- 17. You may not pass if:
- · The solid yellow line is on your side.
- 18. To avoid tailgating, use the \_\_\_\_\_:
- 3 -second rule. When the vehicle ahead of you passes a certain point such as a sign, count "one-thousand-one, one- thousand two, one-thousand-three." If you get to the same spot before you finish counting, you are following too close.
- 19. It is dangerous to drive in a truck's "No Zones" because:
- The truck driver cannot see you.
- 20. When a pedestrian is crossing a street or highway guided by a dog or carrying a white cane (or a white cane with a red tip):
- All vehicles must come to a complete stop.
- 21. When turning, you should use your turn signal at least:
- 100 feet before the turn.

- 22. When passing, it is against the law to:
- Drive off the paved or main traveled portion of the road or on the shoulder.
- 23. If the road has four or more lanes with two-way traffic, drive in:
- · The right lanes except when overtaking and passing.
- 24. Parking is not allowed:
- · On crosswalks.

- 25. When driving slower than the flow of traffic:
- Keep right so that others may pass you.
- 26. If the traffic signal is not working:
- · Treat the intersection as if it is controlled by stop signs in all directions.
- 27. When police, fire, or other emergency vehicles approach drivers should:
- Pull over to the closest edge of the roadway immediately and stop until the emergency vehicle has passed.
- 28. A yellow arrow means:
- The protected turning time is ending. Be prepared to obey the next light (red or green).
- 29. When a school crossing guard is in the crosswalk:
- Drivers must yield or stop at the marked stop line and without stopping in the crosswalk.
- 30. Bicyclists have the same rights and responsibilities on the road as drivers of motor vehicles:

- 31. What is the fastest way to sober up after drinking?
  - Time is the only thing that will get alcohol out of your system. Coffee and cold showers do not work; the alcohol has to be burned off by the liver and the amount of time that takes is different for everyone.

- 34. When entering an interstate or freeway:
- Use the acceleration lane to adjust your speed at or near the speed of traffic on the freeway so you can merge smoothly.
- 35. When stopped for a school bus with its red lights flashing and its stop arm extended, you may not proceed until:
- The bus driver has turned off the flashing red lights and withdrawn the stop arm.
- 36. In Minnesota, the use of a cell phone while driving, with or without a hands-free cell phone device is prohibited for:
- · All drivers under the age of 18.
- 37. Before entering a roundabout, drivers must:
- · Yield to pedestrians and traffic already in the roundabout.
- 38. If another driver does not dim his/her lights:
- · Do not look directly into the oncoming headlights.
- · Look toward the right edge of your lane.
- · Watch the oncoming vehicle out of the corner of your eye.
- 39. When parking uphill with a curb:
- Turn your front wheels away from the curb and let your vehicle roll back a few inches. The wheel should gently touch the curb.
- 40. A green arrow means:
- Go. You must proceed in the direction of the arrow after yielding to pedestrians, bicyclists, and vehicles close enough to be a hazard.
- 41. When passing another vehicle, do not return to the right side of the road until:
- · You can see the headlights/tires of the vehicle you just passed in your rearview mirror.
- 42. If you need to stop after crossing railroad tracks:
- Wait until you can completely cross the tracks before proceeding. Make sure your vehicle clears the tracks before you stop.
- 43. For the first six months, a driver with a probationary license may not operate a motor vehicle between the hours of:
- · midnight and 5:00 a.m.

- 44. Red reflectors always mean you are:
- Facing traffic the wrong way and could have a head-on collision.
- 45. You cannot make a right hand turn on red if:
  - A "No Turn On Red" sign is posted.
- 46. You may pass, if it is safe to do so, when the roadway is marked with a:
  - · Broken yellow line.
- 47. When driving in rain or fog:
  - Use your low beams only and never drive with parking lights only.
- 48. Two solid yellow center lines mean that:
  - · No passing is allowed.
- 49. You can make a right turn at a red light after you:
  - · Stop and yield to pedestrians, bicyclists, and vehicles close enough to be a hazard.
