MVC CHEATS and TIPS! CHEAT QUESTIONS FOR NEW JERSEY

- You should allow extra room between your vehicle and a motorcycle ahead because:
- Motorcyclists can stop much more quickly than a larger vehicle.
- 2. When stopped for a school bus with its red lights flashing and its stop arm extended, you may not proceed until:
- The bus driver has turned off the flashing red lights and withdrawn the stop arm.
- 3. If another driver does not dim his/her lights:
- Do not look directly into the oncoming headlights.
- Look toward the right edge of your lane.
- · Watch the oncoming vehicle out of the corner of your eye.
- 4. If you come upon the victims of a vehicle crash:
- Do not move an injured person who cannot move or complains of pain in the back or neck. Do not attempt to remove the helmet of an injured motorcycle or bicycle rider.
- 5. When police, fire, or other emergency vehicles approach:
- Do not block the intersection.
- 6. Do not attempt to pass unless:
- You are sure there is enough clear space ahead to complete the pass safely.
- 7. Before entering a roundabout, drivers must:
- Yield to pedestrians and traffic already in the roundabout.
- 8. You must follow any lawful orders or directions of:
- Any law enforcement officer or a fireman at the scene who is directing traffic.

- 9. In heavy rain, at speeds above 50 mph, your tires can lose contact with the road and ride on top of the water; this is known as:

- You could be cited for driving "too fast for conditions."

- 23. In New Jersey, a driver under the age of 21 can be convicted of DUI with a Blood Alcohol Content (BAC) of:

35. You must use your headlights:
