# DMV CHEATS and TIPS! CHEAT QUESTIONS FOR NEW YORK

- 1. In New York, a licensed driver under the age of 18:
- Has special time and passenger restrictions based on the region of the state in which he/she lives.
- 2. The Zero Tolerance Law is the law that:
- Makes it illegal for anyone under the age of 21 to consume alcohol.
- 3. In New York, it is against the law for any driver to use a wireless communication device to:
- Send, receive, or read written messages while driving.
- 4. If there is a conflict between the signal light and the directions of a police officer:
- · Obey the police officer not the light.
- 5. A flashing Red signal light means:
- Stop. After stopping, you may proceed when it is safe. Observe the right-of-way rules.
- 6. A yellow arrow means:
- The protected turning time is ending. Be prepared to obey the next light (red or green).
- 7. If the traffic signal is not working:
- Treat the intersection as if it is controlled by stop signs in all directions.
- 8. If a "No Turn On Red" sign is posted:
- · You cannot make a right hand turn on a red light.

- Go. You must proceed in the direction of the arrow after yielding to pedestrians, bicyclists, and vehicles close enough to be a hazard.

- There are no stop signs at any corner and you cannot see for 100 feet in either direction during the last 100 feet before crossing.
- 11. At a four-way stop, if more than one vehicle reaches the intersection at the same time:
- The driver on the left should yield to the driver on the right.
- 12. A roundabout is an intersection where:
- Traffic travels around a central island in a counter-clockwise direction.
- 13. When driving slower than the flow of traffic:
- · Keep right so that others may pass you.

- Double your following distance.
- 33. Roads are most slippery:
- Just after it begins to rain.

- When driving at higher speeds in heavy rain. Your tires can lose contact with the road and ride on top of the water like skis.

#### 43. When exiting a freeway or interstate:

- Wait until you are in the exit lane before slowing down.
- 44. If you miss your exit on an interstate or freeway:
- Do not stop. Proceed on to the next exit.
- 45. If another driver does not dim his/her lights:
  - Do not look directly into the oncoming headlights.
  - · Look toward the right edge of your lane.
  - Watch the oncoming vehicle out of the corner of your eye.
- 46. The "No Zones on a large truck refers to the:
- Large blind spots on all four sides of the truck.
