If Applying for Regular Operator's License (not Learner's Permit)

- 1. You may pass, if it is safe to do so, when the broken yellow line is:
- On your side of the roadway.
- 2. When police, fire, or other emergency vehicles approach:

- 9. Unless otherwise posted, the maximum speed limit on most roads and highways is:

- Do not stop. Proceed on to the next exit.
- 11. When entering an interstate or freeway:
- Use the acceleration lane to adjust your speed at or near the speed of traffic on the freeway so you can merge smoothly.

- 13. When a pedestrian is crossing a street or highway guided by a dog or carrying a white cane (or a white cane with a red tip):
- All vehicles must come to a complet stop.
- 14. Before entering a roundabout, drivers must:
