If Applying for Regular Operator's License (not Learner's Permit)

- 1. Before entering a roundabout, drivers must:
- Yield to pedestrians and traffic already in the roundabout.
- 2. When passing, it is against the law to:
- Drive off the paved or main traveled portion of the road or on the shoulder.
- 3. When parking either uphill or downhill without a curb:
- Turn the wheels so the vehicle will roll away from the center of the road if the brakes fail.
- 4. U-turns are illegal:
- At or on a railroad crossing.
- On a divided highway by crossing a dividing section, curb, strip of land, or two sets of double yellow lines.
- Where you cannot see clearly 200 feet in each direction because of a curve, hill, rain, fog, or other reason.
- Where a "No U-Turn" sign is posted.
- When other vehicles may hit you.
- On a one-way street.
- In front of a fire station. Never use a fire station driveway to turn your vehicle around.
- 5. When passing another vehicle, do not return to the right side of the road until:
- You can see the headlights/tires of the vehicle you just passed in your rearview mirror.
- 6. When a school bus flashes red lights, you must:
- Stop from either direction until the children are safely across the street and the lights stop flashing.
- 7. A flashing Red signal light means:
- Stop. After stopping, you may proceed when it is safe. Observe the right-of-way rules.
- 8. If you miss your exit on an interstate or freeway:
- Do not stop. Proceed on to the next exit.

- 9. It is illegal for anyone over the age of 21 to drive with a Blood Alcohol Content (BAC) of or higher.

- 10. If you see red reflectors facing you on the lane lines:
- · You are on the wrong side of the road.
- 11. The center lane of a three-lane or five-lane highway is used:
- Only for turning left.
- 12. Under Oregon law, drivers are allowed to use hands-free mobile communication devices if:
- They are over the age of 18.
- 13. If another driver does not dim his/her lights:
- · Do not look directly into the oncoming headlights.
- Look toward the right edge of your lane.
- Watch the oncoming vehicle out of the corner of your eye.
- 14. What is the fastest way to sober up after drinking?
- Time is the only thing that will get alcohol out of your system. Coffee and cold showers do not work; the alcohol has to be burned off by the liver and the amount of time that takes is different for everyone.
- 15. If you need to stop after crossing railroad tracks:
- Wait until you can completely cross the tracks before proceeding. Make sure your vehicle clears the tracks before you stop.
- 16. When police, fire, or other emergency vehicles approach:
- Do not block the intersection.
- 17. When police, fire, or other emergency vehicles approach drivers should:
- Pull over to the closest edge of the roadway immediately and stop until the emergency vehicle has passed.
- 18. It is dangerous to drive in a truck's "No Zones" because:
- The truck driver cannot see you.
- 19. Traffic lanes going in the same direction, such as on one-way streets are marked by a:
- · Solid or broken white line.
- 20. If you come upon the victims of a vehicle crash:
- Do not move an injured person who cannot move or complains of pain in the back or neck. Do not attempt to remove the helmet of an injured motorcycle or bicycle rider.

- 21. When driving slower than the flow of traffic:
- · Keep right so that others may pass you.
- 22. When stopped for a school bus with its red lights flashing and its stop arm extended, you may not proceed until:
- The bus driver has turned off the flashing red lights and withdrawn the stop arm.
- 23. A red signal light means:
- Stop.
- 24. You must turn on your headlights:
- Whenever you are driving in rain, fog, or smoke.
- 25. At intersections without "STOP" or "YIELD" signs:
- Slow down and be ready to stop. Yield to traffic and pedestrians already in the intersection or just entering the intersection.
- 26. Do not attempt to pass unless:
- You are sure there is enough clear space ahead to complete the pass safely.
- 27. Oregon law requires that seat belts be worn by:
- The driver and all passengers.
- 28. If the road has four or more lanes with two-way traffic, drive in:
- The right lanes except when overtaking and passing.
- 29. Parking is not allowed:
- Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant.
- 30. The "No Zones" on a large truck refers to the:

33. If your brakes get wet and start to pull to one side:
Slow down and gently pump the brakes until they start to work correctly.
34. Using the rule will help you maintain a safe distance between you and the vehicle ahead.
• 2 to 4 -second rule. When the vehicle ahead of you passes a certain point such as a sign, count "one-thousand-one, one- thousand two, ne- thousand three." If you get to the same spot before you finish counting, you are following too close.
35. If you refuse to submit to a test for drugs or alcohol:
Your driving privileges will be automatically suspended for one year.
36. Medications taken together or used with can be dangerous.

37. The safest speed is:
• One that allows you to have complete control of your vehicle and avoid collisions with other vehicles and pedestrians.
