(not Learner's Permit)

#### 1. The Zero Tolerance Law is the law that:

- Makes it illegal for anyone under the age of 21 to consume alcohol.

#### 2. A flashing yellow signal light means:

- Proceed with caution. Slow down and be especially alert before entering the intersection.

#### 3. A green arrow means:

- Go. You must proceed in the direction of the arrow after yielding to pedestrians, bicyclists, and vehicles close enough to be a hazard.

#### 4. You must follow any lawful orders or directions of:

- Any law enforcement officer or a fireman at the scene who is directing traffic.

#### 5. A flashing Red signal light means:

- Stop. After stopping, you may proceed when it is safe. Observe the right-of-way rules.

#### 6. You cannot make a right hand turn on red if:

- A "No Turn On Red" sign is posted.

#### 7. When two cars enter an intersection without traffic control signs or signals:

- The driver on the left yields to the driver on the right.

#### 8. At a four-way stop, if more than one vehicle reaches the intersection at the same time:

- The driver on the left should yield to the driver on the right.

**9. Before entering a roundabout, drivers must:**

- Yield to pedestrians and traffic already in the roundabout.

**10. A roundabout is an intersection where:**

- Traffic travels around a central island in a counter-clockwise direction.

**11. Unless otherwise posted, the maximum speed limit on most rural roads and highways in Texas is:**

- 70 mph.

**12. Unless otherwise posted, the maximum speed limit in urban districts in Texas is:**

- 30 mph.

**13. When a school crossing guard is in the crosswalk:**

- Drivers must yield or stop at the marked stop line and without stopping in the crosswalk.

**14. Pedestrians and drivers must yield the right-of-way to:**

- Law enforcement vehicles, fire engines and other emergency vehicles using sirens and/ or flashing lights.

**15. It is illegal to pass a vehicle stopped at a crosswalk because:**

- A pedestrian you cannot see may be crossing the street.

**16. A blind pedestrian can be identified by the use of:**

- A guide dog or a white cane (or a white cane with a red tip).

**17. Before entering an intersection:**

- Check more than once for motorcyclists.

**18. You should allow extra room between your vehicle and a motorcycle ahead because:**

- Motorcyclists can stop much more quickly than a larger vehicle.

**19. When passing a bicyclist in a travel lane be sure to allow at least \_\_\_\_\_ between your vehicle and the cyclist.**

- 3 feet

**20. If you need to stop after crossing railroad tracks:**

- Wait until you can completely cross the tracks before proceeding. Make sure your vehicle clears the tracks before you stop.

21. You may not pass if:

- The solid yellow line is on your side.

22. You may pass, if it is safe to do so, when the broken yellow line is:

- On your side of the roadway.

23. HOV lanes on freeways are marked with a:

- White Diamond and the words "Carpool Lane."

24. For the first six months after receipt of a provisional license, a driver under the age of 18:

- May not transport more than one passengers under the age of 21.

25. Center left turn lanes may not be used to:

- Drive more than 200 feet.
- Pass other vehicles.

26. If you are driving slowly on a two-lane highway or road where passing is unsafe, and five or more vehicles are following you:

- Drive into the turnout areas or lanes to let the vehicles pass.

27. Traffic lanes going in the same direction, such as on one-way streets are marked by a:

- Solid white line.

28. When making a right turn:

- Begin and end the turn in the lane closest to the right curb.

29. Before changing lanes:

- Look behind and to both sides to see where other vehicles are located.

30. U-turns are illegal:

- At or on a railroad crossing.
- On a divided highway by crossing a dividing section, curb, strip of land, or two sets of double yellow lines.
- Where you cannot see clearly 200 feet in each direction because of a curve, hill, rain, fog, or other reason.
- Where a "No U-Turn" sign is posted.
- When other vehicles may hit you.
- On a one-way street.
- In front of a fire station. Never use a fire station driveway to turn your vehicle around.

31. Always drive on the right side of a two-lane highway except when:

- Passing.

**32. The center lane of a three-lane or five-lane highway is used:**

- Only for turning left.

**33. When passing another vehicle, do not return to the right side of the road until:**

- You can see the headlights/tires of the vehicle you just passed in your rearview mirror.

**34. If you must drive in fog or smoke:**

- Slow down, turn on your low beam headlights, and be ready for a fast stop.

**35. When driving in rain or fog:**

- Use your low beams only and never drive with parking lights only.

**36. To avoid tailgating, use the \_\_\_\_\_:**

- **Two-second rule.**
  - When the vehicle ahead of you passes a certain point such as a sign, count "one-thousand-one, one-thousand two." If you get to the same spot before you finish counting, you are following too close.

**37. When parking uphill with a curb:**

- Turn your front wheels away from the curb and let your vehicle roll back a few inches. The wheel should gently touch the curb.

**38. When entering an interstate or freeway :**

- Use the acceleration lane to adjust your speed at or near the speed of traffic on the freeway so you can merge smoothly.

**39. You must use your headlights:**

- Between the hours of sunset and sunrise and anytime visibility is limited due to weather or smoke.

**40. If another driver does not dim his/her lights:**

- Do not look directly into the oncoming headlights.
- Look toward the right edge of your lane.
- Watch the oncoming vehicle out of the corner of your eye.

**41. The "No Zones on a large truck refers to the:**

- Large blind spots on all four sides of the truck.

**42. If you come upon the victims of a vehicle crash:**

- Do not move an injured person who cannot move or complains of pain in the back or neck. Do not attempt to remove the helmet of an injured motorcycle or bicycle rider.

**43. The DUI law applies not only for alcohol but also for:**

- Any other drug, including prescription and over-the-counter drugs, that can affect your driving abilities.

**44. By accepting the privilege to drive in this state, you agree to:**

- Permit law enforcement officers to test for the presence of drugs or alcohol if there is a suspicion that you may be driving under the influence.

**45. If you refuse to submit to a test for drugs or alcohol:**

- Your driving privileges will be automatically suspended.

**46. Alcohol impairs your:**

- Your driving privileges will be automatically suspended.

**47. Medications taken together or used with \_\_\_\_\_ can be dangerous.**

- Alcohol

**48. Texas law requires that seat belts be used by:**

- The driver and front seat passengers and all passengers, age 17 and under no matter where they are seated.

**49. Texas law requires that all children be secured in a federally approved child restraint system if they are:**

- Under 5 years of age or less than 36 inches in height.
