#### Driving Skills Exam (behind the wheel)

If Applying for Regular Operator's License  
(not Learner's Permit)

- At a four-way stop, if more than one vehicle reaches the intersection at the same time:
  - The driver on the left should yield to the driver on the right.
- When exiting a freeway or interstate:
  - Give yourself plenty of time to move over to the exit lane and signal your intentions well in advance.
- The DUI law applies not only for alcohol but also for:
  - Any other drug, including prescription and over-the-counter drugs, that can affect your driving abilities.
- You may pass, if it is safe to do so, when the broken yellow line is:
  - On your side of the roadway.
- If the road has four or more lanes with two-way traffic, drive in:
  - The right lanes except when overtaking and passing.
- You can receive a ticket for driving too slowly.
  - TRUE.
- When turning, you should use your turn signal at least:
  - 100 feet before the turn.
- If the traffic signal is not working:
  - Treat the intersection as if it is controlled by stop signs in all directions.

**21. You should allow extra room between your vehicle and a motorcycle ahead because:**

- Motorcyclists can stop much more quickly than a larger vehicle.

**22. Kansas law requires that seat belts be used by:**

- The driver and all passengers.

**23. Before entering a roundabout, drivers must**

- Yield to pedestrians and traffic already in the roundabout.

**24. You must use your headlights:**

- Between the hours of sunset and sunrise and anytime visibility is limited due to weather or smoke.

**25. When making a right turn:**

- Begin and end the turn in the lane closest to the right curb.

**26. If your vehicle starts to skid:**

- Take your foot off the gas.
- Do not apply the brakes.
- Steer in the direction of the skid then steer in the direction you want the car to go.

**27. In Kansas, a driver under the age of 21 can be charged with DUI with a Blood Alcohol Content (BAC) of:**

- You can not make a right hand turn on a red light.

**34. When stopped for a school bus with its red lights flashing and its stop arm extended, you may not proceed until:**

- The bus driver has turned off the flashing red lights and withdrawn the stop arm.

**35. A licensed driver under the age of 17 may not operate a motor vehicle between the hours of:**

- 9:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.

**36. A special freeway lane used only for carpools, buses, motorcycles, or decal low-emission vehicles is known as a:**

- Carpool/High Occupancy Vehicles (HOV ) Lane.

**37. When parking uphill with a curb:**

- Turn your front wheels away from the curb and let your vehicle roll back a few inches. The wheel should gently touch the curb.

**38. Parking is not allowed:**

- On crosswalks.
- On sidewalks.
- In bicycle lanes.
- In front of driveways.

**39. Using the \_\_\_\_\_ rule will help you maintain a safe distance between you and the vehicle ahead.**

- 2 -second rule. When the vehicle ahead of you passes a certain point such as a sign, count "one-thousand-one, one- thousand two." If you get to the same spot before you finish counting, you are following too close.

**40. Drivers must always yield the right-of-way to:**

- Persons who are blind.

**41. Before changing lanes, signal, look in all your mirrors, and:**

- Check traffic behind and beside you.
- Glance over your left or right shoulder to make sure the lane you want is clear.
- Look for all vehicles, motorcyclists, and bicycle traffic in your blind spot.
- Be sure there is enough room for your vehicle in the next lane.

**42. A flashing yellow signal light means:**

- **Proceed with caution. Slow down and be especially alert before entering the intersection.**

**43. You can make a right turn at a red light after you:**

- **Stop and yield to pedestrians, bicyclists, and vehicles close enough to be a hazard.**

**44. Parking is not allowed:**

- **Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant.**

**45. When police, fire, or other emergency vehicles approach drivers should:**

- **Pull over to the closest edge of the roadway immediately and stop until the emergency vehicle has passed.**

**46. A flashing Red signal light means:**

- **Stop. After stopping, you may proceed when it is safe. Observe the right-of-way rules.**

**47. You must turn on your headlights:**

- **Whenever you are driving in rain, fog, or smoke.**
