If Applying for Regular Operator's License
(not Learner's Permit)

1. Red reflectors always mean you are:
 - Facing traffic the wrong way and could have a head-on collision.
2. It is especially difficult to gauge the speed of a motorcycle because:
 - They may appear to be much farther away than they really are.
3. When driving slower than the flow of traffic:
 - Keep right so that others may pass you.
4. If you need to stop after crossing railroad tracks:
 - Wait until you can completely cross the tracks before proceeding. Make sure your vehicle clears the tracks before you stop.
5. In heavy rain, at speeds above 50 mph, your tires can lose contact with the road and ride on top of the water; this is known as:
 - Hydroplaning.
6. If you come upon the victims of a vehicle crash:
 - Do not move an injured person who cannot move or complains of pain in the back or neck. Do not attempt to remove the helmet of an injured motorcycle or bicycle rider.
7. You can make a right turn at a red light after you:
 - Stop and yield to pedestrians, bicyclists, and vehicles close enough to be a hazard.
8. Traffic lanes going in the same direction, such as on one-way streets are marked by a:
 - Solid or broken white line.

9. A yellow arrow means:

- The protected turning time is ending. Be prepared to obey the next light (red or green).

10. If your brakes get wet and start to pull to one side:

- Slow down and gently pump the brakes until they start to work correctly.

11. Parking is not allowed:

- On crosswalks.
- On sidewalks.
- In bicycle lanes.
- In front of driveways.

12. At a four-way stop, if more than one vehicle reaches the intersection at the same time:

- The driver on the left should yield to the driver on the right.

13. The Basic Speed Law means:

- You could be cited for driving "too fast for conditions."

14. You must use your headlights:

- Between the hours of sunset and sunrise and anytime visibility is limited due to weather or smoke.

15. Before changing lanes, signal, look in all your mirrors, and:

- Check traffic behind and beside you.
- Glance over your left or right shoulder to make sure the lane you want is clear.
- Look for all vehicles, motorcyclists, and bicycle traffic in your blind spot.
- Be sure there is enough room for your vehicle in the next lane.

16. Drivers must always yield the right-of-way to:

- Persons who are blind.

17. If you refuse to submit to a test for drugs or alcohol:

- Your driving privileges will be automatically suspended for one year.

18. When parking downhill:

- Turn your front wheels into the curb or toward the side of the road.

19. Under Maine law, a driver under the age of 21 can be charged with OUI if tests show a Blood Alcohol Content (BAC) of:

- Any amount of alcohol in the system.

20. If your vehicle starts to skid:

- Take your foot off the gas.
- Do not apply the brakes.
- Steer in the direction of the skid then steer in the direction you want the car to go.

21. If you must drive in fog or smoke:

- Slow down, turn on your low beam headlights, and be ready for a fast stop.

22. Maine law requires that seat belts be worn by:

- The driver and all passengers.

23. You cannot make a right hand turn on red if:

- A "No Turn On Red" sign is posted.

24. Alcohol impairs your:

- Judgment.

25. Using the _____ rule will help you maintain a safe distance between you and the vehicle ahead.

- 2-second rule. When the vehicle ahead of you passes a certain point such as a sign, count "one-thousand-one, one-thousand two." If you get to the same spot before you finish counting, you are following too close.

26. Medications taken together or used with _____ can be dangerous.

- Alcohol

27. If another driver does not dim his/her lights:

- Do not look directly into the oncoming headlights.
- Look toward the right edge of your lane.
- Watch the oncoming vehicle out of the corner of your eye.

28. A roundabout is an intersection where:

- Traffic travels around a central island in a counter-clockwise direction.

29. Unless otherwise posted, the maximum speed limit in a school zone is:

- 15 mph.

30. What is the fastest way to sober up after drinking?

- Time is the only thing that will get alcohol out of your system. Coffee and cold showers do not work; the alcohol has to be burned off by the liver and the amount of time that takes is different for everyone.

33. When a school bus is flashing its yellow (amber) lights:

- It is about to stop; slow down and prepare to stop.

34. Before entering an intersection:

- Check more than once for motorcyclists.

35. Bicyclists have the same rights and responsibilities on the road as drivers of motor vehicles:

- TRUE.

36. To avoid the possibility of hydroplaning in heavy rains:

- Slow down.

37. When a school bus flashes red lights, you must:

- Stop from either direction until the children are safely across the street and the lights stop flashing.

38. When driving in rain or fog:

- Use you low beams only and never drive with parking lights only.

39. When parking either uphill or downhill without a curb:

- Turn the wheels so the vehicle will roll away from the center of the road if the brakes fail.

40. You may pass, if it is safe to do so, when the broken yellow line is:

- On your side of the roadway.

41. When police, fire, or other emergency vehicles approach:

- Do not block the intersection.

42. A red arrow means:

- **"STOP." Remain stopped until the green signal or green arrow appears. Do not turn against a red arrow.**

43. Before you pull out to pass:

- **Check your blind spots and make sure that you have plenty of time and room to pass.**

44. When making a right turn:

- **Begin and end the turn in the lane closest to the right curb.**

45. If road or weather conditions are not good:

- **Double your following distance.**

46. You should allow extra room between your vehicle and a motorcycle ahead because:

- **Motorcyclists can stop much more quickly than a larger vehicle.**

47. If the traffic signal is not working:

- **Treat the intersection as if it is controlled by stop signs in all directions.**

48. If there is a conflict between the signal light and the directions of a police officer:

- **Obey the police officer - not the light.**

49. When exiting a freeway or interstate:

- **Wait until you are in the exit lane before slowing down.**
