CHEAT QUESTIONS FOR ARKANSAS

1. If you refuse to submit to a test for drugs or alcohol:
 - Your driving privileges will be automatically suspended for 90 days.
2. Unless otherwise posted, the maximum speed limit in a city school zone is:
 - 15 mph.
3. When a pedestrian is crossing a street or highway guided by a dog or carrying a white cane (or a white cane with a red tip):
 - All vehicles must come to a complete stop.
4. A flashing yellow signal light means:
 - Proceed with caution. Slow down and be especially alert before entering the intersection.
5. It is dangerous to drive in a truck's "No Zones" because:
 - The truck driver cannot see you.
6. When police, fire, or other emergency vehicles approach drivers should:
 - Pull over to the closest edge of the roadway immediately and stop until the emergency vehicle has passed.
7. If the traffic signal is not working:
 - Treat the intersection as if it is controlled by stop signs in all directions.
8. It is especially difficult to gauge the speed of a motorcycle because:
 - They may appear to be much farther away than they really are.

9. Stop at least _____ from the nearest track when the crossing devices are active.

10. When two cars enter an intersection without traffic control signs or signals:
 - The driver on the left yields to the driver on the right.
11. Alcohol impairs your:
 - Judgment.
12. Unless otherwise posted, the maximum speed limit on most roads and highways is:
 - 55 mph.
13. Before becoming eligible for a regular driver's license a teen must hold an intermediate license for at least:
 - Six months.
14. When a pedestrian is crossing a public street or highway and the pedestrian is using a walker, a crutch, or an orthopedic cane or wheelchair:
 - All vehicles must come to a complete stop.
15. Motorcyclists can stop much more quickly than a car so you should:
 - Allow extra room between you and a motorcyclist ahead.
16. Do not attempt to pass unless:
 - You are sure there is enough clear space ahead to complete the pass safely.
17. A yellow arrow means:
 - The protected turning time is ending. Be prepared to obey the next light (red or green).
18. The Basic Speed Law means _____ :
 - you may never legally drive faster than the posted speed limit, even if you think it is safe to do so.

- Do not move an injured person who cannot move or complains of pain in the back or neck. Do not attempt to remove the helmet of an injured motorcycle or bicycle rider.

22. HOV lanes on freeways are marked with a:

- White Diamond and the words "Carpool Lane."

23. You may pass, if it is safe to do so, when the roadway is marked with a:

- Broken yellow line.

24. The safest speed is:

- One that allows you to have complete control of your vehicle and avoid collisions with other vehicles and pedestrians.

25. The "No Zones" on a large truck refers to the:

- Large blind spots on all four sides of the truck.

26. The Basic Speed Law means _____:

- you could be cited for driving "too fast for conditions."

27. When a school bus is flashing its yellow (amber) lights:

- It is about to stop; slow down and prepare to stop.

28. If a "No Turn On Red" sign is posted:

- You can not make a right hand turn on a red light.

29. By accepting the privilege to drive in this state, you agree to:

- **“STOP.”** Remain stopped until the green signal or green arrow appears. Do not turn against a red arrow.

33. Between the hours of sunset and sunrise:

- Use your headlights. Never drive with parking lights alone.

34. Center left turn lanes may not be used to:

- Drive more than 200 feet.
- Pass other vehicles.

35. Red reflectors always mean you are:

- Facing traffic the wrong way and could have a head-on collision.

36. Using the _____ rule will help you maintain a safe distance between you and the vehicle ahead.

- 1 car length for every 10 mph

37. If road or weather conditions are not good:

- Double your following distance.

38. Medications taken together or used with _____ can be dangerous.

- Alcohol

39. When entering an interstate or freeway:

- Use the entrance ramp to signal and look for an opening in traffic, adjust your speed to match that of the traffic on the freeway.

40. At intersections without “STOP” or “YIELD” signs:

- Slow down and be ready to stop. Yield to traffic and pedestrians already in the intersection or just entering the intersection.

41. Before entering a roundabout, drivers must:

- Yield to pedestrians and traffic already in the roundabout.

42. You can make a right turn at a red light after you:

- Stop and yield to pedestrians, bicyclists, and vehicles close enough to be a hazard.

43. When parking either uphill or downhill without a curb:

- Turn the wheels so the vehicle will roll away from the center of the road if the brakes fail.

44. To avoid the possibility of hydroplaning in heavy rains:

- Slow down.

45. If you need to stop after crossing railroad tracks:

- Wait until you can completely cross the tracks before proceeding. Make sure your vehicle clears the tracks before you stop.

46. You may pass, if it is safe to do so, when the roadway is marked with a:

- Broken yellow line.

47. Arkansas law requires that federally approved child restraint devices be used by:

- Children under the age of 6.

48. Two solid yellow center lines mean that:

- No passing is allowed.

49. When exiting a freeway or interstate:

- Give yourself plenty of time to move over to the exit lane and signal your intentions well in advance.
