DMV CHEATS and TIPS! CHEAT QUESTIONS FOR CALIFORNIA

- 1. If you are under the age of 18, during the first 12 months after you receive your provisional driver's license you:
- Cannot drive between 11 p.m. and 5 a.m.
- Cannot transport passengers under 20 years of age, unless you are accompanied by a licensed parent or guardian.
- 2. Unless otherwise posted, the speed limit in school zones is:
- 25 mph.
- 3. When a person under______ is not restrained by a safety belt or a child restraint device: A seat belt violation will be charged to the driver
- Sixteen
- 4. California's seat belt law states that:
- The driver and all passengers over the age of 6 must wear a seat belt.
- 5. The Zero Tolerance Law is the law that:
- Makes it illegal for anyone under the age of 21 to consume alcohol.
- 6. You cannot make a right hand turn on red if:
- A "No Turn On Red" sign is posted.
- 7. A red arrow means:
- "STOP." Remain stopped until the green signal or green arrow appears. Do not turn against a red arrow.
- 8. A flashing Red signal light means:
- Stop. After stopping, you may proceed when it is safe.
 Observe the right-of-way rules.







- 9. Always stop for pedestrians:
 - At corners with or without traffic lights, whether or not the crosswalks are marked by painted lines.
- 10. When two cars enter an intersection without traffic control signs or signals:
- The driver on the left yields to the driver on the right.
- 11. A roundabout is an intersection where:
- Traffic travels around a central island in a counter-clockwise direction.
- 12. The safest speed is:
- One that allows you to have complete control of your vehicle and avoid collisions with other vehicles and pedestrians.
- 13. You can receive a ticket for driving so slowly that:
- You impede or block the safe flow of traffic around you.
- 14. When a school bus is flashing its yellow (amber) lights:
- It is about to stop; slow down and prepare to stop.
- 15. When a school crossing guard is in the crosswalk:
- Drivers must yield or stop at the marked stop line and without stopping in the crosswalk.
- 16. When police, fire, or other emergency vehicles approach:
- Do not block the intersection.
- 17. It is illegal to pass a vehicle stopped at a crosswalk because:
- A pedestrian you cannot see may be crossing the street.
- 18. When a pedestrian is crossing a street or highway guided by a dog or carrying a white cane (or a white cane with a red tip):
- All vehicles must come to a complete stop.
- 19. California's child restraint law says that children must use a federally approved child restraint system if:
- They are under eight years of age and less than 4 feet 9 inches tall.
- 20. You should allow extra room between your vehicle and a motorcycle ahead because:
 - Motorcyclists can stop much more quickly than a larger vehicle.

- 21. Before entering an intersection:
- Check more than once for motorcyclists.
- 22. When passing a bicyclist in a travel lane be sure to allow at least ______ between your vehicle and the cyclist.

- 23. Bicyclists have the same rights and responsibilities on the road as drivers of motor vehicles:

- 24. If you need to stop after crossing railroad tracks:
- Wait until you can completely cross the tracks before proceeding. Make sure your vehicle clears the tracks before you stop.
- 25. When passing, it is against the law to:
- Drive off the paved or main traveled portion of the road or on the shoulder.
- 26. Two solid yellow center lines mean that:
- No passing is allowed.
- 27. Center left turn lanes may not be used to:
 - Drive more than 200 feet.
 - Pass other vehicles.
- 28. U-turns are illegal:
- · At or on a railroad crossing.
- On a divided highway by crossing a dividing section, curb, strip of land, or two sets of double yellow lines.
- Where you cannot see clearly 200 feet in each direction because of a curve, hill, rain, fog, or other reason.
- Where a "No U-Turn" sign is posted.
- · When other vehicles may hit you.
- On a one-way street.
- In front of a fire station. Never use a fire station driveway to turn your vehicle around.
- 29. Before changing lanes:
- Look behind and to both sides to see where other vehicles are located.
- 30. When turning, you should use your turn signal at least:
- 100 feet before the turn.
- 31. Red reflectors always mean you are:
 - Facing traffic the wrong way and could have a head-on collision.

32. Before you pull out to pass:

- Check your blind spots and make sure that you have plenty of time and room to pass.
- 33. When driving in rain or fog:
- · Use you low beams only and never drive with parking lights only.
- 34. Hydroplaning occurs:
 - When driving at higher speeds in heavy rain. Your tires can lose contact with the road and ride on top
 of the water like skis.
- 35. Using the _____ will help you maintain a safe distance between you and the vehicle ahead.
- 3 second rule
- When the vehicle ahead of you passes a certain point such as a sign, count "one-thousand-one, one-thousand two, one-thousand three." If you get to the same spot before you finish counting, you are following too close.
- 36. Parking is not allowed:
- On crosswalks.
- On sidewalks.
- In bicycle lanes.
- In front of driveways.
- 37. When parking downhill:
- Turn your front wheels into the curb or toward the side of the road.
- 38. If you miss your exit on an interstate or freeway:
- Do not stop. Proceed on to the next exit.
- 39. When entering an interstate or freeway:
- Use the acceleration lane to adjust your speed at or near the speed of traffic on the freeway so you can merge smoothly.
- 40. If another driver does not dim his/her lights:
 - · Do not look directly into the oncoming headlights.
 - Look toward the right edge of your lane.
 - Watch the oncoming vehicle out of the corner of your eye.
- 41. You must use your headlights:
- Between the hours of sunset and sunrise and anytime visibility is limited due to weather or smoke.



- 42. Following a truck too closely is dangerous because:
- The trucker can't see you and, if he applies his brakes, you could crash into him.
- 43. If you come upon the victims of a vehicle crash:
- Do not move an injured person who cannot move or complains of pain in the back or neck.

 Do not attempt to remove the helmet of an injured motorcycle or bicycle rider.
- 44. By accepting the privilege to drive in this state, you agree to:
- Permit law enforcement officers to test for the presence of drugs or alcohol if there is a suspicion that you may be driving under the influence.
- 45. If you refuse to submit to a test for drugs or alcohol:
- Your driving privileges will be automatically suspended.
