DOR CHEATS and TIPS! CHEAT QUESTIONS FOR COLORADO

- 1. Bicyclists have the same rights and responsibilities on the road as drivers of motor vehicles:
- TRUE
- 2. You may not pass if:
- The solid yellow line is on your side.
- 3. If you come upon the victims of a vehicle crash:
- Do not move an injured person who cannot move or complains of pain in the back or neck. Do not attempt to remove the helmet of an injured motorcycle or bicycle rider.
- 4. You must follow any lawful orders or directions of:
- Any law enforcement officer or a fireman at the scene who is directing traffic.
- 5. A yellow arrow means:
- The protected turning time is ending. Be prepared to obey the next light (red or green).
- 6. If a "No Turn On Red" sign is posted:
- You cannot make a right hand turn on a red light.
- 7. When passing another vehicle, do not return to the right side of the road until:
- You can see the headlights/tires of the vehicle you just passed in your rearview mirror.
- 8. A flashing Red signal light means:
- Stop. After stopping, you may proceed when it is safe. Observe the right-of-way rules.







- 9. A licensed driver under the age of 18 may not operate a motor vehicle between the hours of:
- 12:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m.
- 10. When a school bus flashes red lights, you must:
- Stop from either direction until the children are safely across the street and the lights stop flashing.
- 11. The Basic Speed Law means
- You may never legally drive faster than the posted speed limit, even if you think it is safe to do so.
- 12. At intersections without "STOP" or "YIELD" signs,
- Slow down and be ready to stop. Yield to traffic and pedestrians already in the intersection or just entering the intersection.
- 13. Colorado law prohibits the use of cell phones by drivers under the age of 18 and prohibits _____ for drivers of any age.

- 14. Center left turn lanes may not be used to:
 - · Drive more than 200 feet.
 - Pass other vehicles.
- 15. When turning, you should use your turn signal at least:
 - 100 feet before the turn.
- 16. A roundabout is an intersection where:
- Traffic travels around a central island in a counter-clockwise direction.
- 17. Drivers must always yield the right-of-way to:
- Persons who are blind.
- 18. When exiting a freeway or interstate:
- Wait until you are in the exit lane before slowing down.
- 19. Colorado law requires the use of seat belts by:
- The driver and front seat passengers and passengers under the age of 16 no matter where they are seated.
- 20. The center lane of a three-lane or five-lane highway is used:
 - Only for turning left.

21. Hydroplaning occurs:

- When driving at higher speeds in heavy rain. Your tires can lose contact with the road and ride on top of the water like skis.
- 22. When stopped for a school bus with its red lights flashing and its stop arm extended, you may not proceed
 - The bus driver has turned off the flashing red lights and withdrawn the stop arm.
- 23. You must turn on your headlights:
- Whenever you are driving in rain, fog, or smoke.
- 24. When police, fire, or other emergency vehicles approach:
 - Do not block the intersection.
- 25. When making a right turn:
- Begin and end the turn in the lane closest to the right curb.
- 26. When parking uphill with a curb:
- Turn your front wheels away from the curb and let your vehicle roll back a few inches. The wheel should gently touch the curb.
- 27. If you need to stop after crossing railroad tracks:
- Wait until you can completely cross the tracks before proceeding. Make sure your vehicle clears the tracks before you stop.
- 28. The law that prevents anyone under the age of 21 from consuming alcohol is known as the:
 - · Zero Tolerance law.
- 29. If you refuse to submit to a test for drugs or alcohol:
- Your driving privileges will be automatically suspended for one year.
- 30. When passing, you must return to the right side of the road before coming within ______of any vehicle coming from the opposite direction
 - 200 feet
- 31. An intersection is considered "blind" if:
 - There are no stop signs at any corner and you cannot see for 100 feet in either direction during the last 100 feet before crossing.



- 32. You can receive a ticket for driving too slowly.

- 33. By accepting the privilege to drive in this state, you agree to:
- Permit law enforcement officers to test for the presence of drugs or alcohol if there is a suspicion that you may be driving under the influence.
- 34. In Colorado, for the first six months, a licensed teen under the age of 18 cannot:
- Transport any passengers.
- 35. Unless otherwise posted, the maximum speed limit on urban interstate and highways is:
- 55 mph.
- 36. You may pass, if it is safe to do so, when the broken yellow line is:
- On your side of the roadway.
- 37. To avoid tailgating, use the:
- 3 -second rule. When the vehicle ahead of you passes a certain point such as a sign, count "one-thousand-one, one-thousand two, one-thousand-three." If you get to the same spot before you finish counting, you are following too close.
- 38. If road or weather conditions are not good:
- Double your following distance.
- 39. If the traffic signal is not working:
- Treat the intersection as if it is controlled by stop signs in all directions.
- 40. When entering an interstate or freeway:
- Use the acceleration lane to adjust your speed at or near the speed of traffic on the freeway so you can merge smoothly.
- 41. It is illegal to pass a vehicle stopped at a crosswalk because:
 - A pedestrian you cannot see may be crossing the street.

- 42. The center of a road used for two-way traffic is marked with a:
- Solid or broken yellow line.
- 43. When passing, it is against the law to:
- Drive off the paved or main traveled portion of the road or on the shoulder.
- 44. Blind spots around a large truck are known as:
- "No Zones".
- 45. If you miss your exit on an interstate or freeway:
- Do not stop. Proceed on to the next exit.
- 46. It is especially difficult to gauge the speed of a motorcycle because:
 - They may appear to be much farther away than they really are.
- 47. You can make a right turn at a red light after you:
- Stop and yield to pedestrians, bicyclists, and vehicles close enough to be a hazard.
