- 1. Blind spots around a large truck are known as:
- "No Zones."
- 2. Using the _____ rule will help you maintain a safe distance between you and the vehicle ahead.
- 2 second rule. When the vehicle ahead of you passes a certain point such as a sign, count "one-thousand-one, one- thousand two." If you get to the same spot before you finish counting, you are following too close.
- 3. Roads are most slippery:
- Just after it begins to rain.
- 4. Stop at least _____ from the nearest track when the crossing devices are active.
 - 15 feet, but not more than 50 feet
- 5. You must use your headlights:
- Between the hours of sunset and sunrise and anytime visibility is limited due to weather or smoke.
- 6. The law that prevents anyone under the age of 21 from consuming alcohol is known as the:
 - Zero Tolerance law.
- 7. When parking uphill with a curb:
- Turn your front wheels away from the curb and let your vehicle roll back a few inches. The wheel should gently touch the curb.
- 8. You can make a right turn at a red light after you:

- In front of driveways.
- 24. You must never drive to the left of double solid yellow lines or a solid yellow line on your side of the roadway unless you are:
- Turning left at an intersection.
- Turning into or out of a private road or driveway.
- In a carpool lane that has a designated entrance on the left.
- Instructed by construction or other signs to drive on the left because your side of the road is closed or blocked.
- 25. It is especially difficult to gauge the speed of a motorcycle because:

- · Give yourself plenty of time to move over to the exit lane and signal your intentions well in advance.

- · Law enforcement vehicles, fire engines and other emergency vehicles using sirens and/ or flashing lights.
- 45. The center lane of a three-lane or five-lane highway is used:
- · Only for turning left.
