1. Blind spots around a large truck are known as:
 - "No Zones."
2. Using the _____ rule will help you maintain a safe distance between you and the vehicle ahead.
 - **2 second rule.** - When the vehicle ahead of you passes a certain point such as a sign, count "one-thousand-one, one- thousand two." If you get to the same spot before you finish counting, you are following too close.
3. Roads are most slippery:
 - Just after it begins to rain.
4. Stop at least _____ from the nearest track when the crossing devices are active.
 - 15 feet, but not more than 50 feet
5. You must use your headlights:
 - Between the hours of sunset and sunrise and anytime visibility is limited due to weather or smoke.
6. The law that prevents anyone under the age of 21 from consuming alcohol is known as the:
 - Zero Tolerance law.
7. When parking uphill with a curb:
 - Turn your front wheels away from the curb and let your vehicle roll back a few inches. The wheel should gently touch the curb.
8. You can make a right turn at a red light after you:
 - Stop and yield to pedestrians, bicyclists, and vehicles close enough to be a hazard.

- All vehicles must come to a complete stop.

10. When passing a bicyclist in a travel lane be sure to allow at least _____ between your vehicle and the cyclist.

- 3 feet

11. When two cars enter an intersection without traffic control signs or signals:

- The driver on the left yields to the driver on the right.

12. If a "No Turn On Red" sign is posted:

- You cannot make a right hand turn on a red light.

13. Unless otherwise posted, the maximum speed limit in a school zone is:

- 20 mph

14. Traffic lanes going in the same direction, such as on one-way streets are marked by a:

- Solid white line.

15. U-turns are illegal:

- At or on a railroad crossing.
- On a divided highway by crossing a dividing section, curb, strip of land, or two sets of double yellow lines.
- Where you cannot see clearly 200 feet in each direction because of a curve, hill, rain, fog, or other reason.
- Where a "No U-Turn" sign is posted.
- When other vehicles may hit you.
- On a one-way street.
- In front of a fire station. Never use a fire station driveway to turn your vehicle around.

16. You can receive a ticket for driving too slowly.

20. If you miss your exit on an interstate or freeway:

- Do not stop. Proceed on to the next exit.

21. Hydroplaning occurs:

- When driving at higher speeds in heavy rain. Your tires can lose contact with the road and ride on top of the water like skis.

22. In Florida, if you refuse to submit to a test for drugs or alcohol:

- Your driving privileges will be automatically suspended for six months.

23. Parking is not allowed:

- On crosswalks.
- On sidewalks.
- In bicycle lanes.
- In front of driveways.

24. You must never drive to the left of double solid yellow lines or a solid yellow line on your side of the roadway unless you are:

- Turning left at an intersection.
- Turning into or out of a private road or driveway.
- In a carpool lane that has a designated entrance on the left.
- Instructed by construction or other signs to drive on the left because your side of the road is closed or blocked.

25. It is especially difficult to gauge the speed of a motorcycle because:

- They may appear to be much farther away than they really are.

26. When turning, you should use your turn signal at least:

- 100 feet before the turn.

27. When police, fire, or other emergency vehicles approach drivers should:

30. Before you pull out to pass:

- Check your blind spots and make sure that you have plenty of time and room to pass.

31. Unless otherwise posted, the maximum speed limit in a residential or business zone is:

- 30 mph.

32. The safest speed is:

- One that allows you to have complete control of your vehicle and avoid collisions with other vehicles and pedestrians.

33. It is dangerous to drive in a truck's "No Zones" because:

- The truck driver cannot see you.

34. When driving in rain or fog:

- Use your low beams only and never drive with parking lights only.

35. If your vehicle starts to skid:

- Take your foot off the gas.
- Do not apply the brakes.
- Steer in the direction of the skid then steer in the direction you want the car to go.

36. HOV lanes on freeways are marked with a:

- White Diamond and the words "Carpool Lane."

37. An intersection is considered "blind" if:

- There are no stop signs at any corner and you cannot see for 100 feet in either direction during the last 100 feet before crossing.

42. What is the fastest way to sober up after drinking?

- Time is the only thing that will get alcohol out of your system. Coffee and cold showers do not work; the alcohol has to be burned off by the liver and the amount of time that takes is different for everyone.

43. When exiting a freeway or interstate:

- Give yourself plenty of time to move over to the exit lane and signal your intentions well in advance.

44. Pedestrians and drivers must yield the right-of-way to:

- Law enforcement vehicles, fire engines and other emergency vehicles using sirens and/ or flashing lights.

45. The center lane of a three-lane or five-lane highway is used:

- Only for turning left.

46. When stopped for a school bus with its red lights flashing and its stop arm extended, you may not proceed until:

- The bus driver has turned off the flashing red lights and withdrawn the stop arm.

47. Except in certain circumstances, a licensed Florida driver under the age of 18 cannot operate a motor vehicle without an accompanying licensed driver over the age of 21 between the hours of:

- 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.

48. In Florida, if passengers under the age of 18 aren't wearing seat belts:

- The driver can receive a ticket for each unbelted passenger.

49. Florida law requires that children be placed in a federally approved child safety seat if:

- The child is under 5 years of age.
