DDS CHEATS and TIPS! CHEAT QUESTIONS FOR GEORGIA

- 1. When police, fire, or other emergency vehicles approach:
- Do not block the intersection.
- 2. If another driver does not dim his/her lights:
- Do not look directly into the oncoming headlights.
- Look toward the right edge of your lane.
- Watch the oncoming vehicle out of the corner of your eye.
- 3. When passing, you must return to the right side of the road before coming within ______of any vehicle coming from the opposite direction.
- 200 feet
- 4. When a pedestrian is crossing a street or highway guided by a dog or carrying a white cane (or a white cane with a red tip):
- All vehicles must come to a complete stop.
- 5. Do not attempt to pass unless:
- You are sure there is enough clear space ahead to complete the pass safely.
- 6. Following a truck too closely is dangerous because:
- The trucker can't see you and, if he applies his brakes, you could crash into him.
- 7. When exiting a freeway or interstate:
- Wait until you are in the exit lane before slowing down.
- 8. When entering an interstate or freeway:
- Use the acceleration lane to adjust your speed at or near the speed of traffic on the freeway so you can merge smoothly.







- 9. Two solid yellow center lines mean that:
- No passing is allowed.
- 10. If you miss your exit on an interstate or freeway:
- · Do not stop. Proceed on to the next exit.
- 11. Before you pull out to pass:
- · Check your blind spots and make sure that you have plenty of time and room to pass.
- 12. If road or weather conditions are not good:
- · Double your following distance.
- 13. You must never drive to the left of double solid yellow lines or a solid yellow line on your side of the roadway unless you are:
- · Turning left at an intersection.
- · Turning into or out of a private road or driveway.
- In a carpool lane that has a designated entrance on the left.
- Instructed by construction or other signs to drive on the left because your side of the road is closed or blocked.
- 14. It is illegal to pass a vehicle stopped at a crosswalk because:
- A pedestrian you cannot see may be crossing the street.
- 15. Most medications taken for _____ can make a person drowsy and affect their driving.
- · Colds, hay fever or other allergies or those to calm nerves
- 16. You can receive a ticket for driving so slowly that:
- You impede or block the safe flow of traffic around you.
- 17. During the first six months after receiving a Class D Provisional License:
- · Only immediate family members may ride as passengers in the vehicle.
- 18. If there is a conflict between the signal light and the directions of a police officer:
- · Obey the police officer not the light.
- 19. Before entering an intersection:
- Check more than once for motorcyclists.
- 20. The center of a road used for two-way traffic is marked with a:
- · Solid or broken yellow line.

21. To avoid tailgating, use the _____:

- Two-second rule. When the vehicle ahead of you passes a certain point such as a sign, count "one-thousand-one, one-thousand two." If you get to the same spot before you finish counting, you are following too close.
- 22. Under Georgia's DUI law, anyone under the age of 21 is proven to be "under the influence" with a Blood Alcohol Content (BAC) of:
- · 0.02.
- 23. At a four-way stop, if more than one vehicle reaches the intersection at the same time:
- The driver on the left should yield to the driver on the right.
- 24. Georgia's DUI Law:
- Makes it illegal for anyone under the age of 21 to consume alcohol.
- 25. When making a right turn:
- Begin and end the turn in the lane closest to the right curb.
- 26. A flashing Red signal light means:
- · Stop. After stopping, you may proceed when it is safe. Observe the right-of-way rules.
- 27. Unless otherwise posted, the maximum speed limit in a residential or business zone is:
- 30 mph.
- 28. Under Georgia law seat belts are required for:
- The driver and front seat passengers and anyone under the age of 18 no matter where they are seated.
- 29. Traffic lanes going in the same direction, such as on one-way streets are marked by a:
- · Solid or broken white line.
- 30. If the traffic signal is not working:
- Treat the intersection as if it is controlled by stop signs in all directions.
- 31. You can make a right turn at a red light after you:
- Stop and yield to pedestrians, bicyclists, and vehicles close enough to be a hazard.
