DMV CHEATS and TIPS! CHEAT QUESTIONS FOR ILLINOIS

- 1. A flashing yellow signal light means:
- Proceed with caution. Slow down and be especially alert before entering the intersection.
- 2. To avoid tailgating, use the ______
- 3 second rule. When the vehicle ahead of you passes a certain point such as a sign, count "one-thousand-one, one- thousand two, one-thousand-three." If you get to the same spot before you finish counting, you are following too close.
- 3. When police, fire, or other emergency vehicles approach:
- · Do not block the intersection.
- 4. When exiting a freeway or interstate:
- Wait until you are in the exit lane before slowing down.
- 5. It is illegal for anyone over the age of 21 to drive with a Blood Alcohol Content (BAC) of or higher.

- 6. If your brakes get wet and start to pull to one side:
- Slow down and gently pump the brakes until they start to work correctly.
- 7. When a pedestrian is crossing a street or highway guided by a dog or carrying a white cane (or a white cane with a red tip):
- · All vehicles must come to a complete stop.
- 8. In Illinois, if you refuse to submit to a test for drugs or alcohol:
- Your driving privileges will be automatically suspended for 3 months.

- 18. When two cars enter an intersection without traffic control signs or signals:

- 19. At intersections without "STOP" or "YIELD" signs,
- Slow down and be ready to stop. Yield to traffic and pedestrians already in the intersection or just entering the intersection.
- 20. Traffic lanes going in the same direction, such as on one-way streets are marked by a:

- 21. Unless otherwise posted, the maximum speed limit in a school zone is:
- 20 mph.
- 22. It is illegal to pass a vehicle stopped at a crosswalk because:

- 23. In heavy rain, at speeds above 50 mph, your tires can lose contact with the road and ride on top of the water; this is known as:

- 25. Two solid yellow center lines mean that:
- · No passing is allowed.
- 26. Before changing lanes:
- Look behind and to both sides to see where other vehicles are located.

 - Facing traffic the wrong way and could have a head-on collision.
- 28. Before entering an intersection:
- Check more than once for motorcyclists.
- 29. For the first 12 months after receiving their license, drivers under the age of 21:
 - May not carry more than one passenger.
- 30. Before entering a roundabout, drivers must:
- Yield to pedestrians and traffic already in the roundabout.
- 31. When entering an interstate or freeway:
- Use the entrance ramp to signal and look for an opening in traffic, adjust your speed to match that of the traffic on the freeway.



- 32. You can receive a ticket for driving so slowly that:
- · You impede or block the safe flow of traffic around you.
- 33. When police, fire, or other emergency vehicles approach drivers should:
- Pull over to the closest edge of the roadway immediately and stop until the emergency vehicle has passed.
- 34. If the traffic signal is not working:
- Treat the intersection as if it is controlled by stop signs in all directions.
- 35. Illinois law prohibits the use of cell phones while driving by:
- Anyone under the age of 19.
- 36. You can make a right turn at a red light after you:
- Stop and yield to pedestrians, bicyclists, and vehicles close enough to be a hazard.
- 37. When passing, it is against the law to:
- Drive off the paved or main traveled portion of the road or on the shoulder.
- 38. Blind spots around a large truck are known as:
- "No Zones".
- 39. The Zero Tolerance Law is the law that:
- Makes it illegal for anyone under the age of 21 to consume alcohol.
- 40. When a school bus is flashing its yellow (amber) lights:
- It is about to stop; slow down and prepare to stop.
- 41. An intersection is considered "blind" if:
 - There are no stop signs at any corner and you cannot see for 100 feet in either direction during the last 100 feet before crossing.

- 42. You may not pass if:
- The solid yellow line is on your side.
- 43. Center left turn lanes may not be used to:
- Drive more than 200 feet.
- Pass other vehicles.
- 44. If you miss your exit on an interstate or freeway:
- Do not stop. Proceed on to the next exit.
- 45. When passing a bicyclist in a travel lane be sure to allow at least ______ between your vehicle and the cyclist.

- 46. A roundabout is an intersection where:
- Traffic travels around a central island in a counter-clockwise direction.
- 47. When stopped for a school bus with its red lights flashing and its stop arm extended, you may not proceed until:
 - The bus driver has turned off the flashing red lights and withdrawn the stop arm.
- 48. You must turn on your headlights:
- Whenever you are driving in rain, fog, or smoke.
- 49. If another driver does not dim his/her lights:
- · Do not look directly into the oncoming headlights.
- Look toward the right edge of your lane.
- Watch the oncoming vehicle out of the corner of your eye.
