BMV CHEATS and TIPS! CHEAT QUESTIONS FOR INDIANA

- 1. Hydroplaning occurs:
- When driving at higher speeds in heavy rain. Your tires can lose contact with the road and ride on top of the water like skis.
- 2. At a four-way stop, if more than one vehicle reaches the intersection at the same time:
- The driver on the left should yield to the driver on the right.
- 3. The Basic Speed Law means
- You may never legally drive faster than the posted speed limit, even if you think it is safe to do so.
- 4. Stop at least _____ from the nearest track when the crossing devices are active.
- 15 feet, but not more than 50 feet
- 5. When police, fire, or other emergency vehicles approach drivers should:
- Pull over to the closest edge of the roadway immediately and stop until the emergency vehicle has passed.
- 6. If you miss your exit on an interstate or freeway:
- Do not stop. Proceed on to the next exit.
- 7. Two solid yellow center lines mean that:
- · No passing is allowed.
- 8. A yellow arrow means:
- The protected turning time is ending. Be prepared to obey the next light (red or green).







- 9. At intersections without "STOP" or "YIELD" signs:
- Slow down and be ready to stop. Yield to traffic and pedestrians already in the intersection or just entering the intersection.
- 10. With certain exceptions, the holder of a probationary driver's license is not allowed to carry any passengers for the first ______ days after receiving the license.

- 11. When passing, it is against the law to:
- Drive off the paved or main traveled portion of the road or on the shoulder.
- 12. Always drive on the right side of a two-lane highway except when:
- Passing.
- 13. You may pass, if it is safe to do so, when the broken yellow line is:
- On your side of the roadway.
- 14. When passing another vehicle, do not return to the right side of the road until:
- · You can see the headlights/tires of the vehicle you just passed in your rearview mirror.
- 15. You must turn on your headlights:
- Whenever you are driving in rain, fog, or smoke.
- 16. To avoid tailgating, use the _____:
- 2 to 3 second rule. When the vehicle ahead of you passes a certain point such as a sign, count "one-thousand-one, one-thousand two, one-thousand-three." If you get to the same spot before you finish counting, you are following too close.
- 17. Alcohol impairs your:
- Judgment.
- 18. When a pedestrian is crossing a public street or highway and the pedestrian is using a walker, a crutch, or an orthopedic cane or wheelchair:
- All vehicles must come to a complete stop.
- 19. You should allow extra room between your vehicle and a motorcycle ahead because:
- Motorcyclists can stop much more quickly than a larger vehicle.
- 20. What is the fastest way to sober up after drinking?
 - Time is the only thing that will get alcohol out of your system. Coffee and cold showers do not work; the alcohol has to be burned off by the liver and the amount of time that takes is different for everyone.

- 21. When driving slower than the flow of traffic:
- · Keep right so that others may pass you.
- 22. If a "No Turn On Red" sign is posted:
- · You cannot make a right hand turn on a red light.
- 23. U-turns are illegal:
- At or on a railroad crossing.
- On a divided highway by crossing a dividing section, curb, strip of land, or two sets of double yellow lines.
- Where you cannot see clearly 200 feet in each direction because of a curve, hill, rain, fog, or other reason.
- Where a "No U-Turn" sign is posted.
- · When other vehicles may hit you.
- On a one-way street.
- In front of a fire station. Never use a fire station driveway to turn your vehicle around.
- 24. It is illegal to pass a vehicle stopped at a crosswalk because:
- A pedestrian you cannot see may be crossing the street.
- 25. Before entering a roundabout, drivers must
- Yield to pedestrians and traffic already in the roundabout.
- 26. Blind spots around a large truck are known as:
 - "No Zones".
- 27. The DWI law applies not only for alcohol but also for:
- Any other drug, including prescription and over-the-counter drugs, that can affect your driving abilities.

- Any law enforcement officer or a fireman at the scene who is directing traffic.
- 33. If the traffic signal is not working:
- Treat the intersection as if it is controlled by stop signs in all directions.
- 34. If road or weather conditions are not good:
- · Double your following distance.
- 35. Indiana law requires that seat belts be used by:
 - The driver and all passengers.
- 36. Parking is not allowed:
- Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant.
- 37. You can make a right turn at a red light after you:
- Stop and yield to pedestrians, bicyclists, and vehicles close enough to be a hazard.
- 38. When parking downhill:
- Turn your front wheels into the curb or toward the side of the road.
- 39. When entering an interstate or freeway:
 - Use the acceleration lane to adjust your speed at or near the speed of traffic on the freeway so you can merge smoothly.
- 40. Unless otherwise posted, the maximum speed limit in a residential zone is:
 - 30 mph.
- 41. When a school crossing guard is in the crosswalk:
 - Drivers must yield or stop at the marked stop line and without stopping in the crosswalk.

- 42. When exiting a freeway or interstate:
- · Wait until you are in the exit lane before slowing down.
- 43. If you come upon the victims of a vehicle crash:
- Do not move an injured person who cannot move or complains of pain in the back or neck.
 Do not attempt to remove the helmet of an injured motorcycle or bicycle rider.
- 44. Parking is not allowed:
- On crosswalks.
- On sidewalks.
- In bicycle lanes.
- In front of driveways.
- 45. HOV lanes on freeways are marked with a:
- White Diamond and the words "Carpool Lane."
- 46. The center of a road used for two-way traffic is marked with a:
- Solid or broken yellow line.
