# DOS CHEATS and TIPS! CHEAT QUESTIONS FOR MICHIGAN

- 1. If you refuse to submit to a test for drugs or alcohol:
- Your driving privileges will be automatically suspended for one year.
- 2. Unless otherwise posted, the maximum speed limit in a school zone is:
- 25 mph.
- 3. When two cars enter an intersection without traffic control signs or signals:
- The driver on the left yields to the driver on the right.
- 4. The center lane of a three-lane or five-lane highway is used:
- · Only for turning left.
- 5. What is the fastest way to sober up after drinking?
- Time is the only thing that will get alcohol out of your system.
   Coffee and cold showers do not work; the alcohol has to be burned off by the liver and the amount of time that takes is different for everyone.
- 6. You must never drive to the left of double solid yellow lines or a solid yellow line on your side of the roadway unless you are:
- Turning left at an intersection.
- Turning into or out of a private road or driveway.
- In a carpool lane that has a designated entrance on the left.
- Instructed by construction or other signs to drive on the left because your side of the road is closed or blocked.
- 7. Parking is not allowed:
- Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant.
- 8. When parking either uphill or downhill without a curb:
- Turn the wheels so the vehicle will roll away from the center of the road if the brakes fail.







- 9. If you miss your exit on an interstate or freeway:
  - Do not stop. Proceed on to the next exit.
- 10. Unless otherwise posted, the maximum speed limit in a residential zone is:
- 25 mph.
- 11. Bicyclists have the same rights and responsibilities on the road as drivers of motor vehicles:

- 12. Michigan law requires the use of seat belts by:
- The driver and front seat passengers.
- Anyone under the age of 16, no matter where they are sitting.
- 13. Except under certain conditions, a teen with a Level 2 license may not operate a motor vehicle between the hours of:

- 19. When passing another vehicle, do not return to the right side of the road until:
- You can see the headlights/tires of the vehicle you just passed in your rearview mirror.

- 21. You may pass, if it is safe to do so, when the broken yellow line is:
- On your side of the roadway.
- 22. The safest speed is:
- One that allows you to have complete control of your vehicle and avoid collisions with other vehicles and pedestrians.
- 23. When police, fire, or other emergency vehicles approach drivers should:
- Pull over to the closest edge of the roadway immediately and stop until the emergency vehicle has passed.
- 24. The law that prevents anyone under the age of 21 from consuming alcohol is known as the:
- Zero Tolerance law
- 25. You must turn on your headlights:
  - Whenever you are driving in rain, fog, or smoke.
- 26. If road or weather conditions are not good:
- Double your following distance.
- 27. Stop at least from the nearest track when the crossing devices are active.

- 28. When parking downhill:
- Turn your front wheels into the curb or toward the side of the road.
- 29. The "No Zones on a large truck refers to the:
- Large blind spots on all four sides of the truck.

- Do not move an injured person who cannot move or complains of pain in the back or neck. Do not attempt to remove the helmet of an injured motorcycle or bicycle rider.

- 32. When stopped for a school bus with its red lights flashing and its stop arm extended, you may not proceed until:
- The bus driver has turned off the flashing red lights and withdrawn the stop arm.
- 33. When turning, you should use your turn signal at least:
- 100 feet before the turn.
- 34. If you are driving slowly on a two-lane highway or road where passing is unsafe, and five or more vehicles are following you:
- Drive into the turnout areas or lanes to let the vehicles pass.
- 35. To avoid tailgating, use the \_\_\_\_\_:
  - 3 -second rule. When the vehicle ahead of you passes a certain point such as a sign, count "one-thousand-one, one- thousand two, one-thousand-three." If you get to the same spot before you finish counting, you are following too close.
- 36. When driving in rain or fog:
  - Use you low beams only and never drive with parking lights only.
- 37. By accepting the privilege to drive in this state, you agree to:
- Permit law enforcement officers to test for the presence of drugs or alcohol if there is a suspicion that you may be driving under the influence.
- 38. Center left turn lanes may not be used to:
- Drive more than 200 feet.
- Pass other vehicles.
- 39. You should allow extra room between your vehicle and a motorcycle ahead because:
  - Motorcyclists can stop much more quickly than a larger vehicle.
- 40. When exiting a freeway or interstate:
- Wait until you are in the exit lane before slowing down.
- 41. Before changing lanes, signal, look in all your mirrors, and:
- · Check traffic behind and beside you.
- Glance over your left or right shoulder to make sure the lane you want is clear.
- · Look for all vehicles, motorcyclists, and bicycle traffic in your blind spot.
- Be sure there is enough room for your vehicle in the next lane.



#### 42. A red arrow means:

- "STOP." Remain stopped until the green signal or green arrow appears. Do not turn against a red arrow.
- 43. A driver under the age of 21 who is convicted of driving with a BAC of .02 or higher will have their license suspended for a minimum of:
- 30 days.
- 44. When passing, it is against the law to:
- Drive off the paved or main traveled portion of the road or on the shoulder.
- 45. Traffic lanes going in the same direction, such as on one-way streets are marked by a:
- Solid white line.
- 46. Before you pull out to pass:
- · Check your blind spots and make sure that you have plenty of time and room to pass.
- 47. An intersection is considered "blind" if:
- There are no stop signs at any corner and you cannot see for 100 feet in either direction during the last 100 feet before crossing.
- 48. If a "No Turn On Red" sign is posted:
- · You cannot make a right hand turn on a red light.
- 49. If another driver does not dim his/her lights:
- Do not look directly into the oncoming headlights.
- Look toward the right edge of your lane.
