DMV CHEATS and TIPS! CHEAT QUESTIONS FOR OHIO

- 1. A red signal light means:
- Stop.
- 2. When turning, you should use your turn signal at least:
- 100 feet before the turn.
- 3. Always stop for pedestrians:
- At corners with or without traffic lights, whether or not the crosswalks are marked by painted lines.
- 4. Blind spots around a large truck are known as:
- "No Zones".
- 5. In heavy rain, at speeds above 50 mph, your tires can lose contact with the road and ride on top of the water; this is known as:
- · Hydroplaning.
- 6. Red reflectors always mean you are:
- Facing traffic the wrong way and could have a head-on collision.
- 7. You must follow any lawful orders or directions of:
- Any law enforcement officer or a fireman at the scene who is directing traffic.
- 8. Drivers must always yield the right-of-way to:
- · Persons who are blind.







- A special freeway lane used only for carpools, buses, motorcycles, or decaled low-emission vehicles is known as a:
 - Carpool/High Occupancy Vehicles (HOV) Lane.
- 10. If you are driving slowly on a two-lane highway or road where passing is unsafe, and five or more vehicles are following you:
- Drive into the turnout areas or lanes to let the vehicles pass.
- 11. You should allow extra room between your vehicle and a motorcycle ahead because:
- Motorcyclists can stop much more quickly than a larger vehicle.
- 12. Pedestrians and drivers must yield the right-of-way to:
- · Law enforcement vehicles, fire engines and other emergency vehicles using sirens and/ or flashing lights.
- 13. Ohio law requires that children between the ages of 4 and 8:
- Be secured in an approved booster seat.
- 14. You may not pass if:
- The solid yellow line is on your side.
- 15. By accepting the privilege to drive in this state, you agree to:
- Permit law enforcement officers to test for the presence of drugs or alcohol if there is a suspicion that you may be driving under the influence.
- 16. You must turn on your headlights:
- Whenever you are driving in rain, fog, or smoke.
- 17. Parking is not allowed:
- Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant.
- 18. When entering an interstate or freeway:
- Use the entrance ramp to signal and look for an opening in traffic, adjust your speed to match that of the traffic on the freeway.
- 19. Parking is not allowed:
 - On crosswalks.
 - On sidewalks.
 - In bicycle lanes.
 - In front of driveways.

- 20. When police, fire, or other emergency vehicles approach:
 - · Do not block the intersection.
- 21. To avoid tailgating, use the _____
- 3-second rule. When the vehicle ahead of you passes a certain point such as a sign, count "one-thousand-one, one- thousand two, one-thousand-three." If you get to the same spot before you finish counting, you are following too close.
- 22. If you come upon the victims of a vehicle crash:
- Do not move an injured person who cannot move or complains of pain in the back or neck.
 Do not attempt to remove the helmet of an injured motorcycle or bicycle rider.
- 23. The Basic Speed Law means _____
- You could be cited for driving "too fast for conditions."
- 24. Before entering a roundabout, drivers must:
- Yield to pedestrians and traffic already in the roundabout.
- 25. Unless otherwise posted, the maximum speed limit in a school zone is:
 - 20 mph.
- 26. Do not attempt to pass unless:
- You are sure there is enough clear space ahead to complete the pass safely.
- 27. An Ohio licensed driver who is 16 years old is prohibited from:
- Carrying more than one passenger under the age of 18.
- 28. When two cars enter an intersection without traffic control signs or signals:
 - The driver on the left yields to the driver on the right.
- 29. Under Ohio law, if you refuse to submit to a test for drugs or alcohol:
- Your driving privileges will be automatically suspended for one to five years.
- 30. If your brakes get wet and start to pull to one side:
- Slow down and gently pump the brakes until they start to work correctly.

- · Wait until you are in the exit lane before slowing down.

- The bus driver has turned off the flashing red lights and withdrawn the stop arm.

- · You can see the headlights/tires of the vehicle you just passed in your rearview mirror.
- 43. When a pedestrian is crossing a public street or highway and the pedestrian is using a walker, a crutch, or an orthopedic cane or wheelchair:
- All vehicles must come to a complete stop.
- 44. Unless otherwise posted, the maximum speed limit on most Ohio roads and highways is:
 - 65 mph.
- 45. Before entering an intersection:
- Check more than once for motorcyclists.
- 46. U-turns are illegal:
- At or on a railroad crossing.
- On a divided highway by crossing a dividing section, curb, strip of land, or two sets of double yellow lines.
- Where you cannot see clearly 200 feet in each direction because of a curve, hill, rain, fog, or other reason.
- Where a "No U-Turn" sign is posted.
- · When other vehicles may hit you.
- On a one-way street.
- In front of a fire station. Never use a fire station driveway to turn your vehicle around.
- 47. If the road has four or more lanes with two-way traffic, drive in:
- The right lanes except when overtaking and passing.
