DOT CHEATS and TIPS! CHEAT QUESTIONS FOR PENNSYLVANIA

- In Pennsylvania, if you refuse to submit to a test for drugs or alcohol:
- Your driving privileges will be automatically suspended for one year.
- 2. Hydroplaning occurs:
- When driving at higher speeds in heavy rain. Your tires can lose contact with the road and ride on top of the water like skis.
- 3. When stopped for a school bus with its red lights flashing and its stop arm extended, you may not proceed until
- The bus driver has turned off the flashing red lights and withdrawn the stop arm.
- 4. Between the hours of sunset and sunrise:
- Use your headlights. Never drive with parking lights alone.
- 5. The center lane of a three-lane or five-lane highway is used:
- · Only for turning left.
- 6. You may pass, if it is safe to do so, when the broken yellow line is:
- · On your side of the roadway.
- 7. When making a right turn:
- Begin and end the turn in the lane closest to the right curb.
- 8. When entering an interstate or freeway:
- Use the entrance ramp to signal and look for an opening in traffic, adjust your speed to match that of the traffic on the freeway.







- 9. If a "No Turn On Red" sign is posted:
- · You cannot make a right hand turn on a red light.
- 10. Parking is not allowed:
- On crosswalks.
- On sidewalks.
- In bicycle lanes.
- In front of driveways.
- 11. Unless otherwise posted, the maximum speed limit in a school zone is:
- 15 mph.
- 12. A roundabout is an intersection where:
- Traffic travels around a central island in a counter-clockwise direction.
- 13. If you come upon the victims of a vehicle crash:
- Do not move an injured person who cannot move or complains of pain in the back or neck.
 Do not attempt to remove the helmet of an injured motorcycle or bicycle rider.
- 14. When passing another vehicle, do not return to the right side of the road until:
- · You can see the headlights/tires of the vehicle you just passed in your rearview mirror.
- 15. Roads are most slippery:
- · Just after it begins to rain.
- 16. Before changing lanes, signal, look in all your mirrors, and:
- · Check traffic behind and beside you.
- Glance over your left or right shoulder to make sure the lane you want is clear.
- Look for all vehicles, motorcyclists, and bicycle traffic in your blind spot.
- Be sure there is enough room for your vehicle in the next lane.
- 17. Pedestrians and drivers must yield the right-of-way to:
- Law enforcement vehicles, fire engines and other emergency vehicles using sirens and/ or flashing lights.
- 18. Center left turn lanes may not be used to:
- Drive more than 200 feet.
- · Pass other vehicles.

- 19. Bicyclists have the same rights and responsibilities on the road as drivers of motor vehicles:
- · True.
- 20. Pennsylvania law requires that seat belts be worn by the driver and front seat passengers as well as:
- Any passenger under the age of 18, no matter where they are sitting.

- All vehicles must come to a complete stop.

- · The truck driver cannot see you.

- · Obey the police officer not the light.
- 34. If you miss your exit on an interstate or freeway:
- Do not stop. Proceed on to the next exit.
- 35. If your vehicle starts to skid:
- Take your foot off the gas.
- Do not apply the brakes.
- Steer in the direction of the skid then steer in the direction you want the car to go.
- 36. The law that prevents anyone under the age of 21 from consuming alcohol is known as the:
- Zero Tolerance law.
- 37. If you need to stop after crossing railroad tracks:
- Wait until you can completely cross the tracks before proceeding.
 Make sure your vehicle clears the tracks before you stop.
- 38. When police, fire, or other emergency vehicles approach:
- Do not block the intersection.
- 39. If your brakes get wet and start to pull to one side:
- · Slow down and gently pump the brakes until they start to work correctly.
- 40. The safest speed is:
- One that allows you to have complete control of your vehicle and avoid collisions with other vehicles and pedestrians.

- Proceed with caution. Slow down and be especially alert before entering the intersection.

45. Using the	rule will help you maintain a safe distance betw	een you and the vehicle ahead.

- Four second rule When the vehicle ahead of you passes a certain point such as a sign, count "one-thousand-one, one- thousand two, etc." If you get to the same spot before you finish counting, you are following too close.
- 46. It is illegal to pass a vehicle stopped at a crosswalk because:
- A pedestrian you cannot see may be crossing the street.
- 47. HOV lanes on freeways are marked with a:
 - White Diamond and the words "Carpool Lane."
- 48. If the traffic signal is not working:
- Treat the intersection as if it is controlled by stop signs in all directions.
- 49. You must never drive to the left of double solid yellow lines or a solid yellow line on your side of the roadway unless you are:
- Turning left at an intersection.
- Turning into or out of a private road or driveway.
- In a carpool lane that has a designated entrance on the left.
- Instructed by construction or other signs to drive on the left because your side of the road is closed or blocked.
