CHEAT QUESTIONS FOR VIRGINIA

- 1. In heavy rain, at speeds above 50 mph, your tires can lose contact with the road and ride on top of the water; this is known as:
- Hydroplaning.
- 2. At a four-way stop, if more than one vehicle reaches the intersection at the same time:
- The driver on the left should yield to the driver on the right.
- 3. When passing a bicyclist in a travel lane be sure to allow at least ______ between your vehicle and the cyclist.

- 4. When parking uphill with a curb:
- Turn your front wheels away from the curb and let your vehicle roll back a few inches. The wheel should gently touch the curb.
- 5. By accepting the privilege to drive in this state, you agree to:
- Permit law enforcement officers to test for the presence of drugs or alcohol if there is a suspicion that you may be driving under the influence.
- 6. You may pass, if it is safe to do so, when the broken yellow line is:
- On your side of the roadway.
- 7. When stopped for a school bus with its red lights flashing and its stop arm extended, you may not proceed until:
- The bus driver has turned off the flashing red lights and withdrawn the stop arm.
- 8. When passing another vehicle, do not return to the right side of the road until:
- You can see the headlights/tires of the vehicle you just passed in your rearview mirror.





- 9. The safest speed is:
- One that allows you to have complete control of your vehicle and avoid collisions with other vehicles and pedestrians.
- 10. The center lane of a three-lane or five-lane highway is used:
- Only for turning left.
- 11. For the first year, a teen with a provisional driver's license may not transport more than ______ passenger/s under the age of 18.

- 12. Center left turn lanes may not be used to:
- Drive more than 200 feet.
- Pass other vehicles.
- 13. To maintain a safe distance between you and the vehicle ahead, us the:
- 2 -second rule. When the vehicle ahead of you passes a certain point such as a sign, count "one-thousand-one, one-thousand two." If you get to the same spot before you finish counting, you are following too close.
- 14. When passing, it is against the law to:
- Drive off the paved or main traveled portion of the road or on the shoulder.
- 15. When driving slower than the flow of traffic:
- Keep right so that others may pass you.
- 16. You must use your headlights:
- Between the hours of sunset and sunrise and anytime visibility is limited due to weather or smoke.
- 17. When entering an interstate or freeway:
- Use the entrance ramp to signal and look for an opening in traffic, adjust your speed to match that of the traffic on the freeway.
- 18. If you are driving slowly on a two-lane highway or road where passing is unsafe, and five or more vehicles are following you:
- Drive into the turnout areas or lanes to let the vehicles pass.
- 19. A yellow arrow means:
- The protected turning time is ending. Be prepared to obey the next light (red or green).
- 20. Red reflectors always mean you are:
- · Facing traffic the wrong way and could have a head-on collision.

- 21. Before entering an intersection:
- · Check more than once for motorcyclists.
- 22. If you refuse to submit to a test for drugs or alcohol:
- · Your driving privileges will be automatically suspended.
- 23. You can make a right turn at a red light after you:
- Stop and yield to pedestrians, bicyclists, and vehicles close enough to be a hazard.
- 24. If you need to stop after crossing railroad tracks:
 - Wait until you can completely cross the tracks before proceeding. Make sure your vehicle clears the tracks before you stop.
- 25. A special freeway lane used only for carpools, buses, motorcycles, or decaled low-emission vehicles is known as a:
- Carpool/High Occupancy Vehicles (HOV) Lane.
- 26. Virginia law prohibits drivers from using cell phones or any other wireless communication device while driving if they are:
- Under the age of 18.
